Save Our Summer 2010 Scholarship Program Organize A Summer Blood Drive To Win

Overview:

Students must organize a blood drive that collects a minimum of 50 units of blood (\$1,000 scholarship) or a drive that collects a minimum of 35 units of blood (\$500 scholarship) from volunteer donors. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a winner who successfully plans a blood drive that meets the 50 units of blood and criteria. Five \$500 scholarships will be awarded to winners who successfully plan a blood drive that meets a minimum of 35 units of blood and criteria.

How to get started:

Go to www.nfbcblood.org to print out the 2010 Save Our Summer Registration Form and fax to 850-475-9288 or mail to Northwest Florida Blood Services, Save Our Summer Registration, 1999 East Nine Mile Road, Pensacola, Florida 32514. See details for participation information and criteria.

Once you have submitted your registration form, a Northwest Florida Blood Services Community Relations Representative that works with your high school will call and set up a meeting to discuss a plan.

Find a blood drive location with the help of your community relations representative.

Recruit and schedule donors from friends, family, neighbors and classmates.

Criteria:

Host a blood drive between the dates of June 1, 2010 and August 15, 2010 to be entered to win. Winners will be announced August 25, 2010.

Attend a post-secondary institution (e.g. colleges, universities, community colleges, institutions, technical centers).

All checks will be sent directly to the college, university or other learning establishment that the student attends after high school.
